Set on approximately three quarters of an acre in the small hamlet of Epping Forest, the main building is Georgian and is constructed of blue stone and granite and built circa 1820. The external walls are up to three foot thick with massive timbers supporting the roof.

Originally built as a coaching inn, the main building now comprises 3 bedrooms, two bathrooms, kitchen, lounge/dining, study, plus double garage/ workshop, studio and self contained guest accommodation with en suite in a secluded garden and courtyard setting.

Up the original staircase you will find the main bedroom with walk-through robe and en suite with large spa bath, guest bedroom, dressing room (or third bedroom) and guest bathroom.

Both the upper and lower levels have reverse cycle air conditioning and the main house has four working fireplaces including a pot belly
